

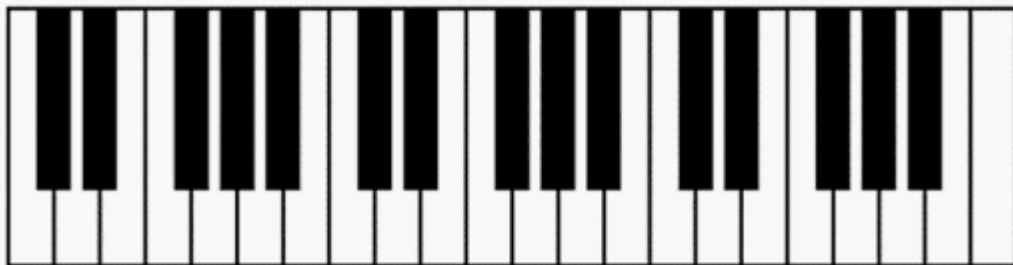
Piano Notes Chart

The piano notes charts helps you to locate the right key on the keyboard when reading a note. Keep in mind that NOTES are written symbols on a 5 line staff with either a Treble or Bass Clef.

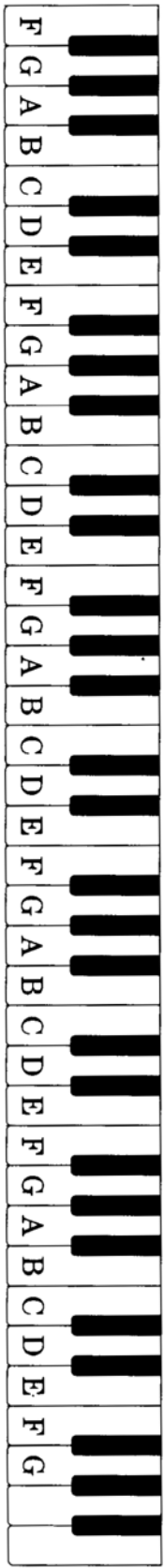


Each Note has an assigned key

on the keyboard.



The following chart gives you the assignment for common notes to the respective key on the Keyboard.
